To the Parents/Guardians of Midway School District:

As of March 11, 2020, Kern County health officials report there are no known cases of the coronavirus (COVID-19) in Kern County. However, in an effort to ensure that we keep our students, staff and our community in a safe environment, and given the uncertainty of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) at this time, we are cancelling all March field trips:

- Kern County Museum on March 17<sup>th</sup>
- Six Flags Magic Mountain on March 26<sup>th</sup>
- John's Incredible Pizza on March 27<sup>th</sup>

We will continue to monitor reports and updates from Kern County Public Health on the spread of the Coronavirus and evaluate if and when these events can be rescheduled. Thank you for your understanding.

The CDC still recommends that the public take every day preventative actions for viruses and diseases, including:

- Stay at home if you have a fever or are feeling sick. Remain at home until the fever has been gone for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medicines.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when sneezing or coughing. If using a tissue, throw the tissue in the trash after sneezing or coughing into it.
- Wash your hands with soap and water often for at least 20 seconds. Use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a standard disinfecting household cleaning spray or wipe.
