

# Proposition 28: Arts and Music in Schools Act — School Site Expenditure Plan

## Background

The Proposition 28: the Arts and Music in Schools (AMS) Act provides an annual source of funding for arts education in California, between \$800 million and \$1 billion each year. Each school is required to submit an annual board-approved report to post on the school district’s and Department of Education’s website that details the types of arts education programs funded by the program.
